### THE BIDEN/IN-COMING TRUMP ADMINISTRATION/EXECUTIVE BRANCH

November 18, 2024. President-elect Donald Trump announced that he is nominating former US Representative Sean Duffy as his US DOT Secretary. Sean Duffy served as the US Representative for Wisconsin's 7<sup>th</sup> Congressional District from 2011 to 2019. During his tenure, he served on the Financial Services, Budget and Joint Economic Committees. Mr. Duffy was also a Fox News contributor. Mr. Duffy will be instrumental in working with Congress on the next surface transportation reauthorization proposal. See nearby picture.

### APPROPRIATIONS/BUDGET - **HOUSE/SENATE THUD APPROPRIATIONS STATUS**

*[As of 12/6/24 – there is no change in status since the November 2024 Board Report.]* The status on FY 2025 appropriations has not changed since Congress skedaddled out of Washington D.C. after both chambers passed a [Continuing Resolution \(CR\)](#)<sup>i</sup> on September 25, 2024, to continue funding government operations. The current CR expires on December 20; so, at this point, another stopgap bill could be the only viable way forward to avoid a government shutdown.

December 2, 2024. The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) issued a [Notice of Funding Opportunity<sup>xxi</sup>](#) (NOFO – and [here<sup>xxii</sup>](#)) making available \$5 million from FYs 2022-2024 in Public Transportation Innovation Program funds for a competitive cooperative agreement (to one competitively selected application) to develop and manage a new [FTA Technology Transfer \(T2\) Program<sup>xxiii</sup>](#). The purpose of a T2 program is to promote the early deployment and demonstration of innovation in public transportation that has broad applicability to public transportation. FTA will host a webinar on December 10, 2024 to discuss the requirements of the NOFO and how to apply. [Register<sup>xxiv</sup>](#). **Applications are due by February 11, 2025.**

November 15, 2024. The US DOT [announced<sup>xxv</sup>](#) 257 “[FY 2024 Safe Streets and Roads for All \(SS4A\)<sup>xxvi,xxvii</sup>](#)” Round Three grant awards totaling \$172 million to local, regional, and Tribal Communities - making communities more walkable and connected. A full list of FY 2024 awards (Round 1, Round 2 and Round 3) can be found [here<sup>xxviii</sup>](#). A SS4A Fact Sheet can be found [here<sup>xxix</sup>](#). The FY 2025 Notice of Funding Opportunity is expected to be released before the end of March 2025. Approximately \$2 billion will be made available in future funding rounds (FY 2025 and FY 2026). **CCTA was awarded a \$1.6 million planning and demonstration award.**

### OTHER TRANSPORTATION-RELATED FEDERAL REGISTER NOTICES

December 2, 2024. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) issued a [Final Decision Notice<sup>xxx</sup>](#) (and [here<sup>xxxi</sup>](#)) adding four new advanced driver assistance systems (ADAS) technologies—blind spot warning (BSW), blind spot intervention (BSI), lane keeping assist (LKA), and pedestrian automatic emergency braking (PAEB)—to the New Car Assessment Program (NCAP) and enhances the performance evaluation of ADAS technologies currently in NCAP. Decisions on planned changes to the New Car Assessment Program are effective for the 2026 model year.

November 18, 2024. The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) issued a [Notice of Extension of Buy America Waiver<sup>xxxii</sup>](#) extending the October 25, 2022, waiver for vans and minivans (for mass-produced, unmodified non-ADA accessible vans and minivans with seating capacity for at least six adults not including the driver). [FTA’s Buy America statute<sup>xxxiii</sup>](#) requires that rolling stock, including vans and minivans, must have more than 70-percent domestic content and that final assembly must occur in the United States.

FTA has extended its waiver for five years in response to stakeholder requests. Final assembly of these vehicles must occur in the United States, and to maximize domestic content, the waiver requires that the engines or motors must be manufactured in the United States. The waiver is available to all FTA grant recipients. **The waiver expires five years after November 18, 2024.**

### GOVERNMENT NOTICES/REPORTS/NEWS ARTICLE




**November 18, 2024.** The Government Accountability Office (GAO) issued a report entitled, “[Transit Workforce Development: Actions to Support Transition to Zero-Emission Buses<sup>xxxiii</sup>](#).” Greenhouse gas emissions from public transportation can be reduced by transitioning to zero-emission (e.g., electric) buses. The use of zero-emission buses is expected to triple by 2030. According to Federal Transit Administration (FTA) data, zero-emission buses comprised 2 percent of the bus fleet for large urban transit agencies nationwide in fiscal year 2022 (2,061 zero-emission buses). FTA projects that zero-emission buses or other vehicles in operation will more than triple by fiscal year 2030 (to 7,700). See highlights paper [here<sup>xxxiv</sup>](#).

**November 13, 2024.** The Government Accountability Office (GAO) issued a report entitled, “[Transportation Grants: Implementation of Recommendations to Improve Documentation Would Enhance Program for Large, Complex Projects<sup>xxxv</sup>](#).” The Department of Transportation's Mega program funds large, complex projects that are likely to generate economic, mobility, or safety benefits nationally or regionally. Mega projects include highways, bridges, and intercity transit and passenger rail. The GAO reported that US DOT did not fully document its rationale for choosing certain projects. The GAO found that US DOT can improve the transparency of the selection process for the Mega program by implementing previous GAO discretionary grant program recommendations. ## SCUTTLEBUTT/ICYMI

November 15, 2024. [Caltrain announced<sup>xxxviii</sup>](#) it sold 19 of its F40 locomotives and 90 of its recently retired gallery cars to Lima, Peru, for a new commuter rail service. The equipment was deemed surplus following the electrification of Caltrain between San Francisco and San Jose. Caltrain is being paid \$6 million for the locomotives and cars. In September, Caltrain launched its new electrified schedule, transforming the 160-year-old San Francisco to San Jose rail corridor from diesel to electric power.
