

Iron Horse & Contra Costa Canal Trails Connection Feasibility Study

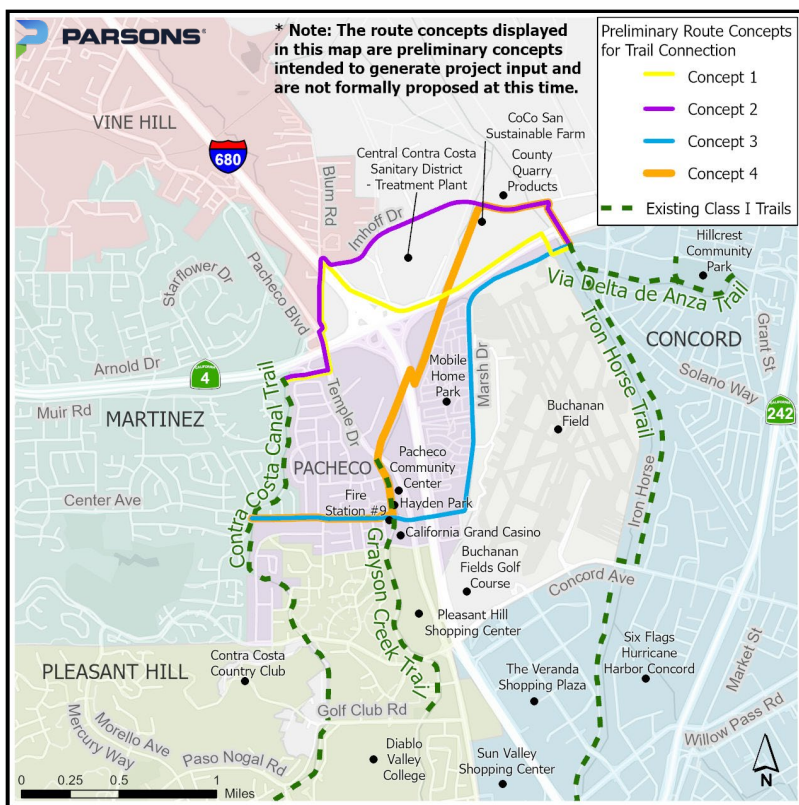


Purpose

Define alternatives to connect the Iron Horse & Contra Costa Canal Trails in the vicinity of The I-680/SR-4 Interchange.



CCTA is leading coordination with multiple jurisdictions and stakeholders in developing and evaluating alternatives that could continue the all ages & abilities user experience through a gap closure in the multi-use pedestrian & bicyclist, low-stress paved trail network.



Study Goals

- Identify planning priorities and potential trail route alignments to advance toward preliminary design/engineering.
- Investigate environmental constraints.
- Collect feedback from stakeholders and identify design goals.
- Determine preliminary cost estimates and timelines.
