Summary of Issues	Staff and consultant will provide a presentation on the State Route 4 (SR 4) Corridor Vision Study (Study), which will examine the transportation infrastructure along SR 4 extending from Interstate 80 (I-80) in the City of Hercules to the San Joaquin County line. The objective of the Study is to examine the transportation infrastructure along the corridor, encompassing SR 4, transit (rail and bus), freight (trucking, rail, and ports), arterials, and active transportation, to define and prioritize future infrastructure investments along the SR 4 corridor within Contra Costa County.
